Thoughts from Astwell Benefice

I suspect it comes as no surprise to anyone that down the centuries the worship for a Saint's Feast Day has always included a shared meal.

But were you aware that this 'feast' was as much a part of the worship as the said or sung liturgy of The Word and The Eucharist?

Those previous generations who gathered to mark a Saint's Day would never consider leaving until the eating part was also over. To do so would mean leaving midway through the act of worship.

Today, at our churches, this continuous act of worship - liturgy and feast - is still offered at our Patronal Services. But today the demands on our lives means that we tend to end our commitment to this special worship at the "sending out",

when we should stay as it continues through the shared fellowship of the Feast Day 'bring and share' part of this service.

As Christians we are called to be a community who eat and drink together in the fellowship of the Lord, to sit at table together, just as our Lord did with his disciples, and successive generations have done so ever since.

And so next week, at the Feast Day of St Mary Magdalene, please don't leave half way through our service. Instead, please stay to continue to worship with us and let's make sure the tradition of Christian community feasting services never ends!
