Minutes of the BPCC MEETING Monday 17th April 2023,

The meeting opened with Prayer (PS)

Present: FH, MS, AP, CB, SW, PS, CN, PB, BE, SR

Apologies: PO, JE, WS, ST

The main purpose of this meeting was to approve the 2022 APCM report and Accounts

- 1. **Approval of minutes of previous BPCC meeting, 17**th **April 2023 (attached):** These were approved unanimously
- 2. **Approval of draft 2022 APCM Report & Accounts (attached):** These were approved unanimously.
- 3. Brief updates by Committee Chairs and Churchwardens/representatives:
 - Lois Weedon: FH is not resigning. The year had got off to a good start financially and attendance is up. 2 new church council members had been recruited – Sue Greenaway and Alice Gregory.
 - **Helmdon** (see attached notes): CN mentioned their problems with the sound system and a general discussion followed on this subject.
 - **Syresham** (see attached notes): A recent Quinquennial inspection had highlighted 158 items that needed addressing!
 - Whitfield (see attached notes) Patronal Songs of Praise was fixed for 3pm on 21st May.
 - **Wappenham** village intending to run a History weekend in August which the church will be involved in.
 - Worship: Following a report by PS dated 10th April (attached) in which he highlighted recent problems of communication within the Benefice, it was suggested that if a service could not be held or similar, there should be an agreed person in each Parish who should be contacted by telephone, and that person would then 'cascade' down the information within their Parish.
